## Hearth

One of the big openings in Kirkland this year, this bar restaurant inside the Heathman Hotel downtown started early and late happy hours for revelers around the park waterfront. It offers mini Kobe beef burgers and other bites (\$4-\$5). Offering better value, especially for a group, are gourmet flatbreads topped with duck confit or wild mushrooms (\$10-\$13). The daily cocktail special costs \$5, and at night, the hard stuff (mescal and whiskey), also gets slashed to five bucks.
