No Work Turkey Dinner: Family Restaurants Serving Thanksgiving Feasts

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Thanksgiving is just around the corner (eek!) which means it's almost time to indulge in the quintessential meal of the year. Instead of getting up at the crack of dawn to prepare a crowd-pleasing feast, consider dining out. From straight-up traditional Thanksgiving menus to vegetarian versions of turkey and stuffing, we've rounded up the best places to dine out on Turkey Day. Psst...call and reserve a table now; most restaurants are only open for limited hours on Thanksgiving.

Trellis Restaurant at The Heathman Hotel

Trellis Restaurant at The Heathman Hotel in Kirkland will be serving a three-course prix fixe menu on Thanksgiving. Choose from four different starters: organic salad with spiced walnuts, local apple, dried cherries and a mustard walnut vinaigrette and brioche croutons, roasted baby beets, PNW oysters or cauliflower cappelletti. Entrées will consist of smoked turkey, hazelnut sage and sourdough stuffing, cranberry compote, sweet yams, fluffy whipped potatoes and pan gravy. Other entrées options (at an additional fee) include grilled eye of ribeye, scallops, smoked venison, pan roasted wild stripe bass and honey glazed game hen. And to round off your meal, a choice between pumpkin cheesecake, pecan tart, dark chocolate mousse or an apple puree with apple chips and crème fraiche.

The kids' menu will consist of a smaller three-course meal, including smoked turkey, mashed potatoes and gravy, sweet potatoes, stuffing and assorted vegetables. Of course, Trellis will also have kid faves on the menu, including cheeseburgers and fries (\$10), grilled cheese and tomato soup (\$8) and chicken and fries (\$8).
